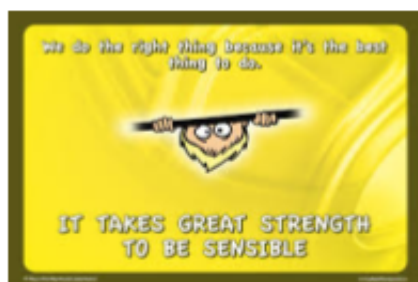


UPCOMING SCHOOL EVENTS:
