From the Ryland Learning Community Learning Pit:

Literacy Reading for meaning is the essence of why we read. To be entertained, informed and persuaded through literature. Be sure to ask your child to retell the story or share some interesting facts they have read. In Year 2, we are having a big focus on this. Ask your child to prove their thinking by locating the information in the text.

Maths Be sure to practice your goals. Check that your child can count forwards and backwards from any starting number using a variety of number patterns, for example; skip counting by 2's, 5's and 10's. Then moving onto more challenging patterns by skip counting by 3's and 7's. This will assist children in solving problems and make connections to multiplication and division. Next week, we will be doing check ins with the children to see how their Math Growth Points have progressed.
