Book Week Dress Up Day: Friday 21st August

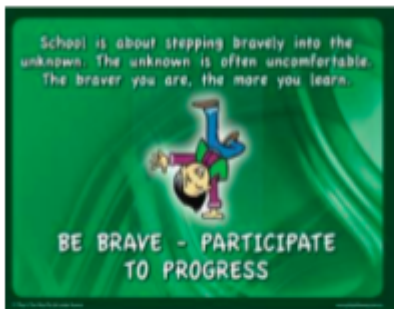
