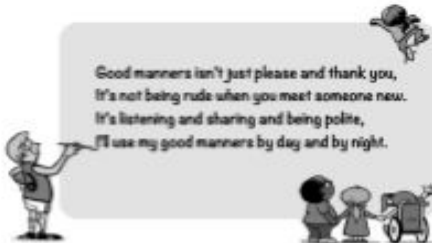
Welcome to Week 1, Term 3!
